

# PENN STATE SAT REVIEW COURSE at South Fayette High School

January, 5, 7, 11, 14, 19, 21, 2010

In preparation for the January 23, 2010 National SAT Exam

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This eighteen (18) hour program is designed to assist high school students preparing to take the SAT exam. The course will familiarize students with test components and test questions and problems. Actual questions from previous SATs will be used for practice. Both math and verbal sections will be covered. The course will also enhance students' current verbal and math skill levels.

## MATERIALS TO BE USED

*The Official SAT Study Guide: For the New SAT*, The College Board

Students will gain valuable experience by taking eight practice tests and receiving estimated scores. With more than 800 pages and 21 chapters, this book helps raise students' confidence through a review of concepts, test-taking approaches, and focused sets of practice questions. Students can increase their understanding of the new SAT through detailed descriptions of the new SAT math, critical reading, and writing sections.

## INSTRUCTORS

Penn State Beaver Mathematics and English faculty members will teach the math and verbal sections, respectively, of the review course. Each instructor is familiar with the exam and the steps necessary to prepare for success on the test. If requested, the faculty will be available outside of class sessions to discuss questions and tips.
